SUNDAY OBLIGATION

For that reason, Catholics are **obliged to come to Mass on Sundays and holy days** (or their vigils) unless they have a serious reason. The obligation was temporarily removed during the pandemic but is now **restored from Easter Sunday** (17th April 2022).

15th Star FORTITUDE (one of the four Cardinal Virtues and one of the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit).

More than any other phrase in Scripture, Lord, you tell us not to be afraid. If this is so, then why do I suffer from worry and insecurity in my dark interior rooms, where shadows whisper, "You are not safe" and "Brace yourself for stark tomorrows"? How can I, with King David, affirm with defiance: The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom should I fear? The LORD is my life's refuge; of whom should I be afraid? When evildoers come at me to devour my flesh, these my enemies and foes themselves stumble and fall. Though an army encamp against me, my heart does not fear; though war be waged against me, even then do I trust. One thing I ask of the LORD; this I seek: To dwell in the LORD's house all the days of my life, to gaze on the LORD's beauty, to visit His temple. For God will hide me in His shelter in time of trouble, He will conceal me in the cover of His tent; and set me high upon a rock. Even now my head is held high above my enemies on every side! I will offer in His tent sacrifices with shouts of joy; I will sing and chant praise to the LORD. (Ps 27: 1 - 6). My courage depends upon whether or not I live in faith. You, Jesus, must be my brother; You, Father, have to be my Father; you, and You, Holy Spirit, my Spirit. Envelope me, God, pervade me, breathe inside of me, then yes . . . afraid of what? Whom? God is the Omnipotent One, and that Omnipotence lives and breathes within me! Only when I fully embrace and believe this, will I stand against the enemies of my soul and shout with glorious liberty: "Who can be against me?"

Prayer for the Synod 2021-2023: We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts. Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.
