# 13th Star - KNOWLEDGE (one of the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit)

It is one thing to speak of a snow bank; but to fall headlong into one is another experience altogether. It is one thing to take a picture of a mom staring lovingly into the eyes of her child; it is quite another to see through the eyes of that mother. To have the mental concept of a fever is not to suffer through one. To learn why birds fly is not the same as soaring through the air with expansive wings. To simply read Holy Scripture is not to know it in one's heart. God, too, is not a concept, theory, or theology. He is a Person, a Person who can be known and followed through an experiential relationship. Facts and verses, stored and memorized, do not a prophet make. A catechized person may express articles of faith articulately, even poetically; but a prophetic witness is also fashioned from solitary, prolonged encounters, face to face, with the Lord. The greatest friends of Jesus are forged on their knees, daily, in intense prayer. These are the ones who see the whole spectrum of creative things insofar as they lead us to God, who can discern life through the eyes of the supernatural. These are the disciples that the Church needs and desires. I ask you, Lord, now, to help me to be one of Your true prophets. Help me forever seek Your presence and intimate embrace. If I do not, I will never know You.
